The Appalachian Master of Health Administration program is a hybrid online program designed to meet the needs of working professionals. The program equips graduates with the competencies to be progressive, strong, and dynamic leaders of health care organizations throughout western North Carolina, the state, and nation.

## Convenience of an Online Program

By offering courses online through Appalachian Distance Education, the program makes available to working professionals the opportunity to earn a master of health administration degree from an institution with forty years of experience educating health care management students. The MHA maintains the rigor and quality for which the baccalaureate health care management program is known.

## Part-time or Full-time Options

The 46 credit hour program offers part-time and full-time enrollment. Students enrolled full-time can complete the program in two years. The flexibility of the program allows part-time students to complete the program in three years. With on-campus time limited to 2-3 days a year, the program is designed around a versatile schedule that enables busy health care professionals to balance work and personal life with a strategic investment in their career.
